Assessment rules and criteria for students in Middle School (MS).

1. Learning outcomes achieved by Middle School students are graded according to the following scale:

Grade	Numerical representation
Excellent	7
Very good	6
Good	5
Average	4
Mediocre	3
Poor	2
Failed	1

2. Assessment criteria and their descriptors, expressed in the form of grades, are found in the Middle School Subject Guides, as well as in the Coordinator's Handbook. The subject teacher is obligated to present the criteria to students and to discuss them in detail.

3. A Middle School student will be promoted to the next class if he/she meets the following conditions:

- A. Receives at least a 3 in each of the subjects
- B. Fulfills all duties and obligations defined in the Community and Service Programme
- C. Has followed and adhered to all rules and procedures outlined in the Academic Honesty

4. The final subject grade is awarded by the subject teacher.

5. For a student to finish and graduate from the Middle School programme, he/she has to:

- A. Fulfill conditions stated in point 3
- B. Receive at least a 3 in the Final Project. The Final Project criteria and descriptors are described in the Final Project Guide.

6. Students following the Middle School programme are not eligible for retake or classifying exams.

7. Only in exceptional circumstances (lingering illness, unfortunate accidents, etc.) the Teachers Council may grant permission for a student to take a retake exam.

8. Conditions and procedures relating to retake exams are defined in chapter 2, paragraph 5 of this document.
