Assessment rules and criteria for students in the Middle School (MS).

1. Learning outcomes achieved by Middle School students are graded according to the following scale:

2. The subject teacher is obliged to present the subject criteria to students in a written form and discuss them in detail. The set criteria follow the core curriculum, including the proprietary curriculum fit for a specific grade.
3. A Middle School student will be promoted to the next class if he/she meets the following conditions:
 - a. Receives at least 51% in each of the subjects.
 - b. Fulfills all duties and obligations defined in the Community and Service Programme.
 - c. Has followed and adhered to all rules and procedures defined as the Academic Honesty.
4. The final subject grade is awarded by the subject teacher.
5. For a student to finish and graduate from the Middle School programme, he/she has to:
 - a. Fulfill conditions stated in point 3.
 - b. Complete the Final Project criteria and descriptors of which are defined in the Final Project Guide.
6. Conditions and procedures relating to retake and classification exams are defined in Section 2 of Regulations document.
